Research Topic

Based on his review of the literature, his personal observations, and the results of a survey study, Mr. Ahmad sought to tell the story what kind of political socialization families and schools are providing to children in Taipei. The study focused on four main themes: (i) nurturing children's values and norms in relation to political issues; (ii) the attitudes and behaviors of students towards different political institutions and authority figures who play key roles in decision making; (iii) the role of schools and families as political agents in promoting political values; and (iv) the cognitive growth of children with regard to the political process.
